A. Assistant Dean for International Programs: Advocate for the foreign students; social activities that bring foreign and domestic students together; introductions during orientation, etc.

B. Committee on Graduate Programs: Programming on teaching foreign students and eliciting their knowledge; testing on what foreign graduate students contribute, etc.
